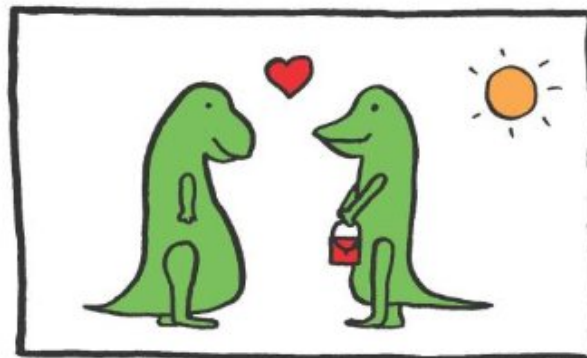

I was wrong. This book contains illustrations on one page and a short continuation of the story on the adjacent page. With this combination, it's only contains about 8 pages of context. The story itself is awkward to read, and despite the fantastic reviews, I found it to be kind of shallow. I was really hoping to find a cute, quirky book that I could give to my husband that would in some way, resemble a love story. I saw a multitude of reviews that stated this book was used during wedding ceremonies, etc. The female meets the male, melts his heart, they learn to accept each other, and suddenly they're old and telling stories. All of this was condensed into about 6-8 pages of text. Examples (not verbatim to the text): "The lovely other dinosaur came along and melted his cage of ice" - page over. "The lovely dinosaur liked shopping but it wasn't a total flaw" - page over.
