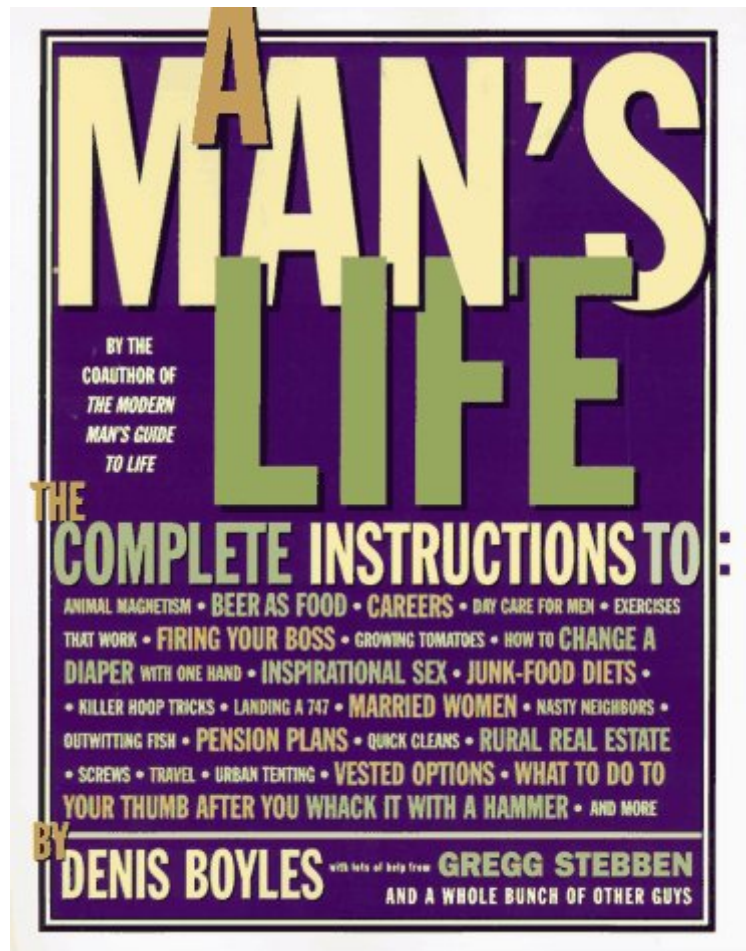

There are sixteen chapters of wit and wisdom: Hardware Machinery; Technology; Housework; Clothes; Fitness, Health, and Grooming; Food; Brians; Money; Work; Trouble; Women; Family Life; Manners and Morals; Agriculture and Livestock (no joke); Outdoors; and Miscellaneous Know-How.Some of the most useful snippets I've found in the book are on how to patch a friendship damaged by neglect, how to give yourself a perfect shave if you can't get to a barber, how to figure out how to achieve financial

independence, how to land a 747 in case of emergency, how to breakup with a woman in a relationship.
