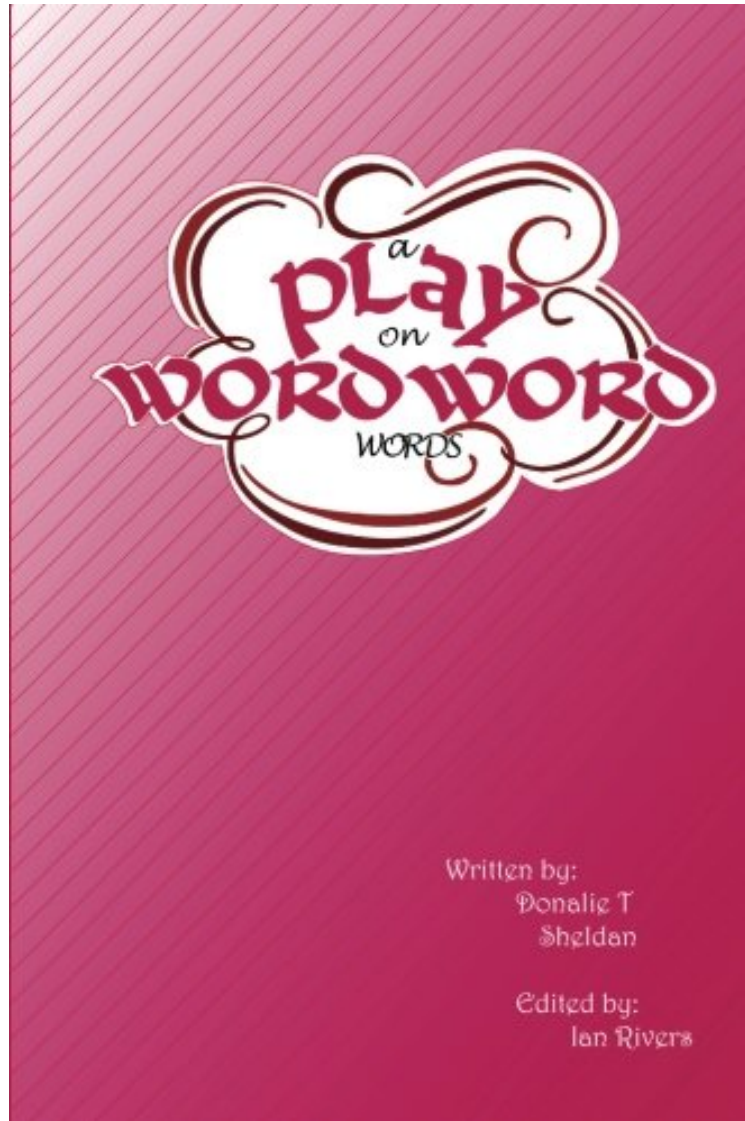

This book is a great way to liven up a party. The puzzles and humorous book titles are fun to pour over alone but even more fun to share. The 184 puzzles in the first "Play on Words" section use double entendre, relative positioning and graphic representations of words to depict other words, expressions, terms and titles. The general premise for solving

these puzzles is best explained by example. You may be familiar with: 2 GOOD 2 BE 4 GOTTEN (Too good to be forgotten) and TWDEEPO is “In too deep”. In the first example you see the use of homonyms (words that sound the same but are spelled differently) and in the second example you can see how prepositions (words expressing a relation to other words: in, out, over, under etc.) are used. Directional words like up, down, back, etc. are also represented visually with the text. As you ponder them the puzzles can take you into that place in your mind where stress simply melts away as something to be addressed later. The second section is made up of 187 “Humorous Book Titles and Their Authors” which play with homonyms that are created by the authors’ names. You may have heard of these two: “Under the Bleachers” by: Seymour Butts (see more butts) or “Yellow River” by: I. P. Freely (I pee freely). A few in the book represent the sound of a regional accent but don’t worry the solutions are all in the back if you don’t immediately see the connection. The last section of the book, “Words for the Betterment of Reasoned Discourse”, is a collection of around 135 words and their definitions. People are using these words when discussing the most important issues of our time, and those who don’t know their meaning may be feeling left out. These words can empower one and hopefully encourage him/her to become active in forming our world. If you gift these words to others, we could all be talking the same language and finding solutions for our future. There are two blank pages following that you can use to add relevant words or create your own puzzles and humorous book titles.
