For instance, a "long dachshund named Stretch/whose owner insisted he fetch...now looks like a pretzel, poor wretch." Some of the vocabulary or jokes may be beyond young children. ("PU" university for a skunk, a "well-balanced meal" for a seal, a "greyhound" who serves as a bus.) Despite some lapses in scanning, agreement of tenses, or flow of language, the limericks are best read aloud. The pen-and-wash illustrations, however, are busy and
