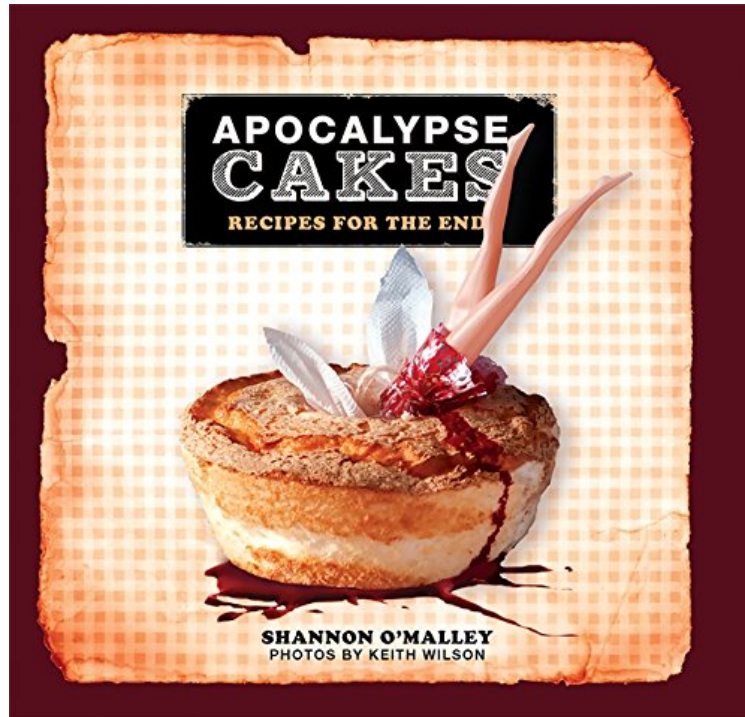

A lot of the recipes require ingredients that aren't easily obtained at a common grocery store (wheat starch, custard powder, etc.), and some are joke recipes that really serve no purpose other than a quick chuckle. I wanted to make the Mayan 2012 cupcakes, which had cinnamon and chili powder in a chocolate cupcake, but either there was a misprint as to the ingredient quantity, or the recipes just weren't tested. You can't make cupcakes with only 1/3 cup of flour and expect them to turn out well (they didn't). However, if

you just want something quirky to put on your coffee table, it does just fine.
