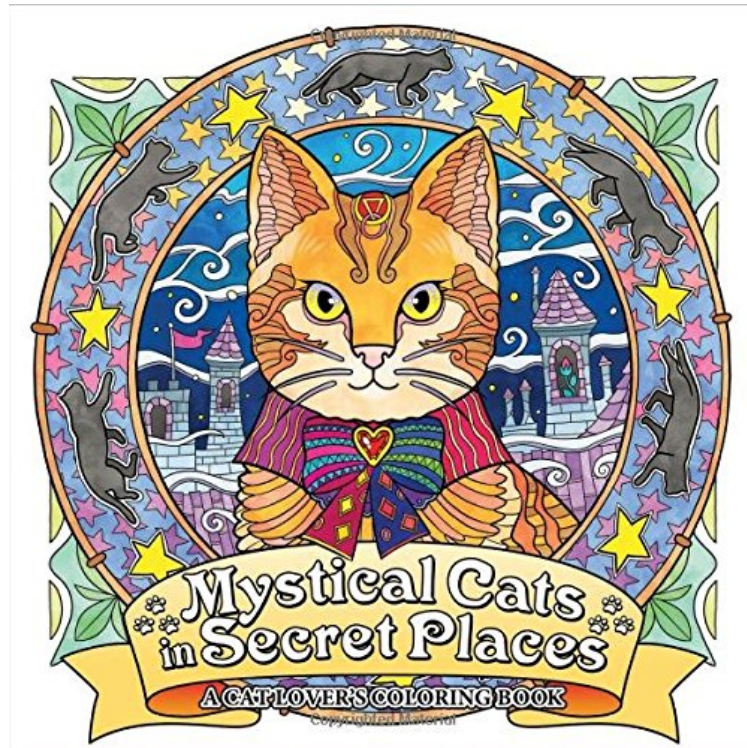

There are 80 adorable designs to color. The paper is a good weight and bright white, non-perforated. The designs are on both sides of the page, so markers will go through. Colored pencils will be ideal, and fineliners such as Staedtler and Stabilo should also work fine. The designs are detailed, but not enough to be overwhelming or take days to finish one picture. What's also great is that each picture is confined to one page, so no coloring in the middle, thank goodness! There isn't a picture in the book that I don't wish to color. My favorite has to be the Moscow cats standing in front of St. Basil's. I'm itching to get home and start coloring. The artwork is beautifully drawn by Honoel A. Ibardolaza. This is a new artist for me but I am sure to buy any other coloring books that the artist releases. The cat designs in the book are fun to look at and even more fun to color. There are simply so many, it is hard to choose where to start (though I started with what I

call the Cinderella cat.)The artwork is reminiscent of that of Marjorie Sarnat's "Creative Cats" but with even more detail if you can imagine it. That there are 80 designs to color in this book makes it a real bargain. The only draw back is that the designs are printed on both sides of the page and that limits me as far as what I want to use to color the designs. The easy solution is to purchase another copy of the book and I am giving a lot of thought to that as the price is so good for the amount that is included.The designs are definitely intricate and many have small details. It might not be the best choice of coloring books for anyone who has vision or fine motor issues but if you can color in tiny spots, it is a beautiful book to add to your cat coloring book library.I've had cats as pets for many years but over the last year, the last of my very senior cats have passed away. For now, coloring cats will be my way of remembering my little friends. This book has so many different cats, its easy for me to see my little ones in their faces and attitudes.This is what I discovered while coloring in this book and testing the paper for coloring medium:80 Imaginative Cat DesignsPrinted on both sides of the pagePaper is heavyweight, white, slightly smooth and non-perforatedGlue BoundOnly 2 Designs merge into the binding area; none spread across two pagesAlcohol-based markers bleed through this paperWater-based markers, except for Tombow brush end markers, can leave spots on the back of the page. The spots are small but you can see them on the other design.Gel pens and India ink pens do not bleed through the page.Colored pencils work well with the paper. The pictures are charming without being cartoonish, with both small and large detail to color in. All pics are clear, complete and there are no repeats. Most images fill the page, a few left with borders but all full size. Granted, the pictures are printed on both sides of the paper but I just bought a second copy and solved that problem. The paper itself is thicker with smooth grain and has held up well to colored pencils, gel pens and metallic pens with very little bleed-through though I'd still place paper behind it to be safe. I have found it easier to cut out individual pages to color them (the pages aren't perforated) but the X-Acto knife made fast work of that. Well worth the price
