The poems are broken into groups, sort of like chapters but somehow not - "Look Out Stomach, Here It Comes! (Poems about eating silly things)," "We All Scream For Ice Cream (Poems about eating foods we like)," "Never Eat More Than You Can Lift (Poems about eating too much)," and "My Mother Says I'm Sickening (Poems about manners at the table)." The writing ranges from mildly amusing to wildly hilarious. Bad grammar and terrible punctuation - and there's a little of both, because poetry lives outside those rules - couldn't mar the perfection of this book. It is wild and colorful, exuberant and gross, lyrical and limerick-al. Best of all, I learned something: there's a lot of poetry about food! The first time your child announces that s/he hates poetry, this is your answer. No
