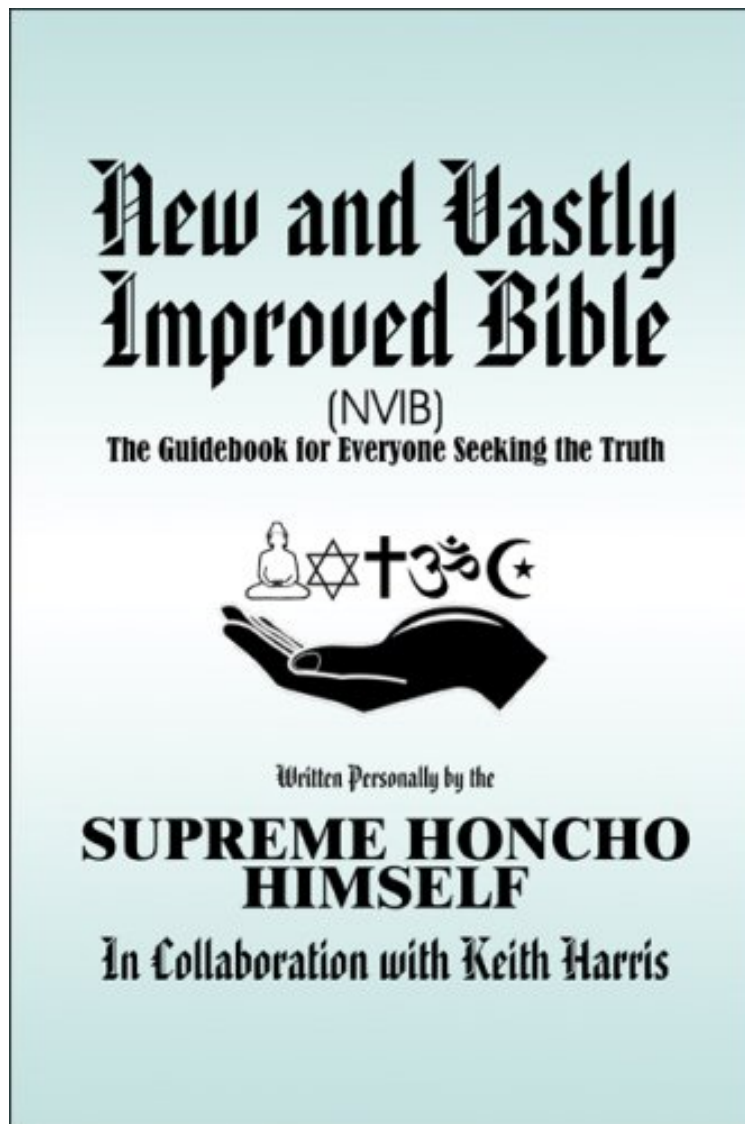

This "Bible" is not another one of the bazillions of translations of the "Other Bible," the one that is many times referred to as the "Good Book." (What's so good about it anyway?) This is a brand new guide to the truth! It is a tongue-in-cheek "Bible," whimsically written from the first-person perspective of "God" (in collaboration with Keith Harris, of course). It is based on what the Bible and religion would be like if Keith Harris were God and thus able to state his religious beliefs in the way he feels they should be stated in the 21st century. This "Bible" is intended for readers who are at the beginning of their journey into questioning traditional religious beliefs (usually the religion of their parents) and folks who don't mind having a laugh along the way. The reader does not need to be well versed in religion, theology, or philosophy in order to understand this Bible, but some knowledge of the "Other Bible" does help to understand the humor and the ironies. This Bible is written in what might be called a folksy tone, some readers comparing the writing style to that of Dave Barry.
