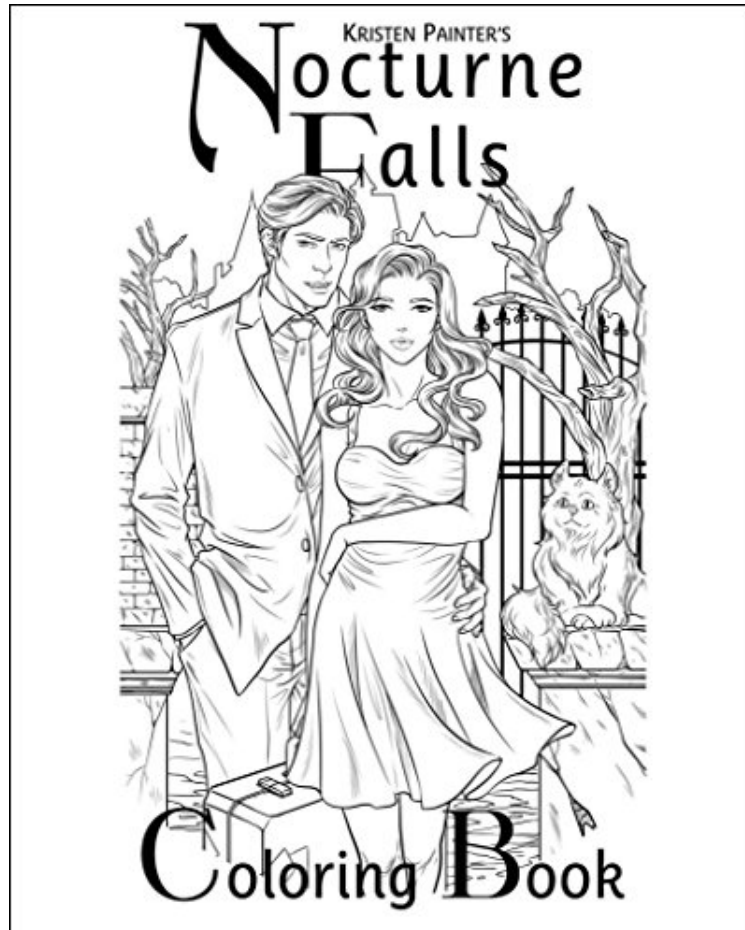

There are 24 images on both sides of the page. The illustrations are excellent. Well-drawn and with gorgeous detail. From clothing draping to facial expressions. Intricate embellishments (though never too detailed that it will frustrate you) and each page tells a story. The pages are not perforated and each image goes to the spine, though the book opens flat so you will not have trouble getting color into the spine. The one pick is that if you use markers you will have bleed-through (paper is medium weight). The alcohol markers bled through the most for me and regular felt-tips had minimal show through. Having not read any of the stories I picked an image that called to me and I used a lot of sparkle gels on this one to make the jewelry twinkle. Lots of fun! (Sorry, didn't have good lighting for the picture; it really does sparkle.) And you know? I've downloaded one of Painter's

stories to check out her world. (There are a few free novellas at if you want to do so.) After coloring in this book I'm ready to dive into the fictional world of Nocturne Falls.
