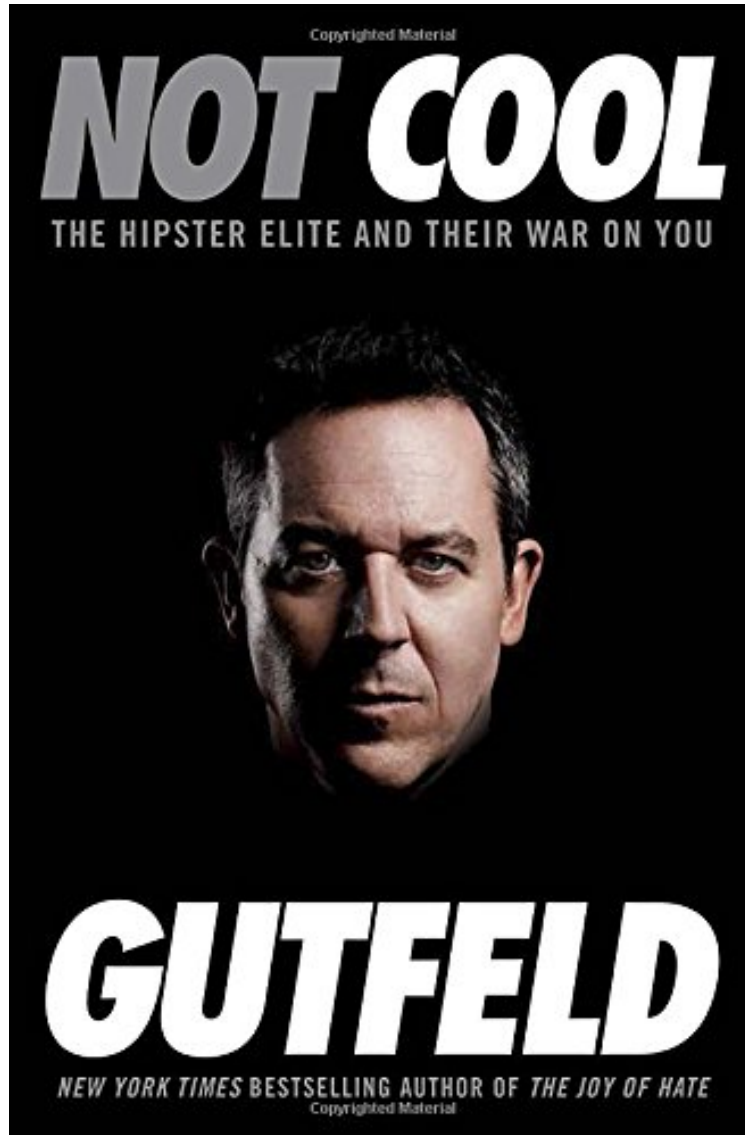

it. It helps to understand and enjoy this book, if one has seen at least a bit of Gutfeld on his late-night show, "Red Eye," or although less help, his appearances on Fox's "The Five." I say that because his style of writing is similar to how he presents information on television. That probably is because much of his televised appearances seems to be reading what is written. In short, although he appears on television, he seems to be more of a writer than a television personality, but the asides and contradictions presented for humorous effect, seem to be more understandable, and effective, when spoken than when written.
