disappointed to find out instead of a thoughtfully crafted take on American history, this book was a regurgitation of the propagandist rewriting of history adopted by many ethnocentric ideologues. I know that Rius is a political cartoonist and this should be taken into account, but he repeats some of the untruths that even most high school students know to be false. Beyond criticizing the political history of the US he claims that the US doesn't have culture (even Anthropology 101 students know this is impossible). He says that jazz isn't American, that it's 100% African. False. Jazz is the uniquely American fusion of European melodies and harmonies with African rhythms. The errors are countless. Obviously Rius creates the history he wants to believe at the cost of the truth. The hypocrisy lies in the fact that he commits the same error of the old nationalist histories by presenting one dogmatic view supporting his nationalistic agenda. If you want to read a well-researched and critical history of the US, buy Howard Zinn's "A People's History of the United States".
