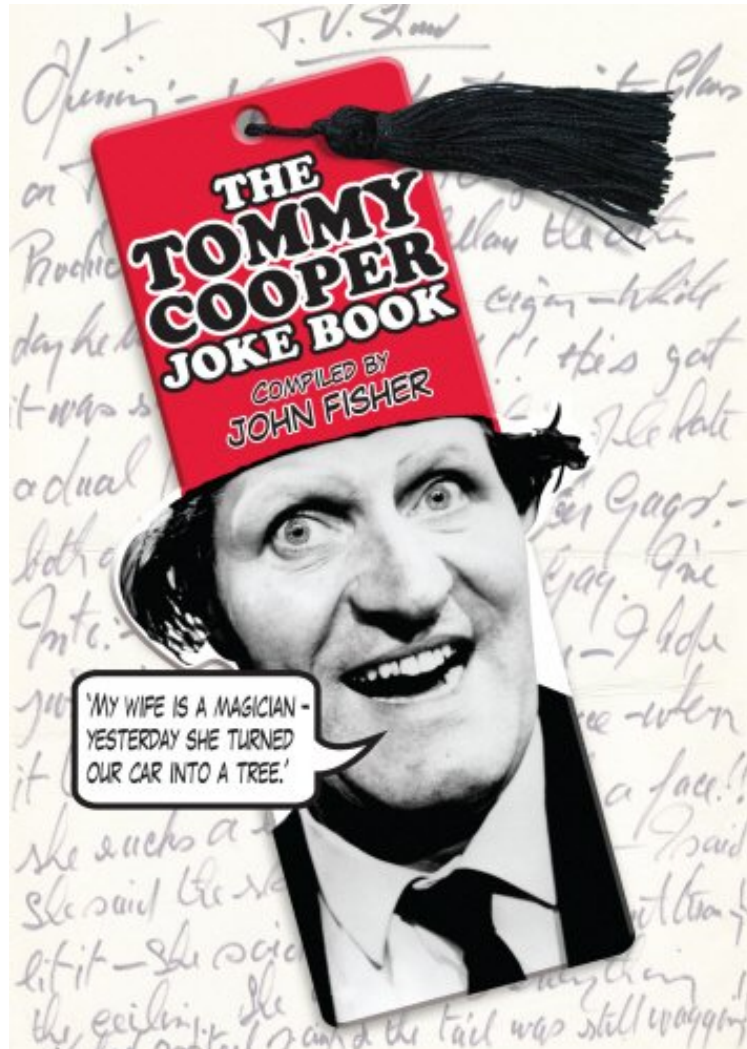

Tommy Cooper died on stage at Her Majesty's Theatre, London, 25 years ago in April 1984 and is still revered today as one of the greatest comedians of the second half of the 20th century. More than just a comedian, Tommy Cooper

was a born entertainer. Working in a golden age of British comedy, Cooper stood literally head and shoulders above the crowd, and had a magical talent for humor that defied description. With a love of laughter stemming from a magic performance gone wrong when he was in his teens, Cooper enlisted in the army in 1939 and began to perfect his comic timing on his army colleagues in the Egyptian desert.
