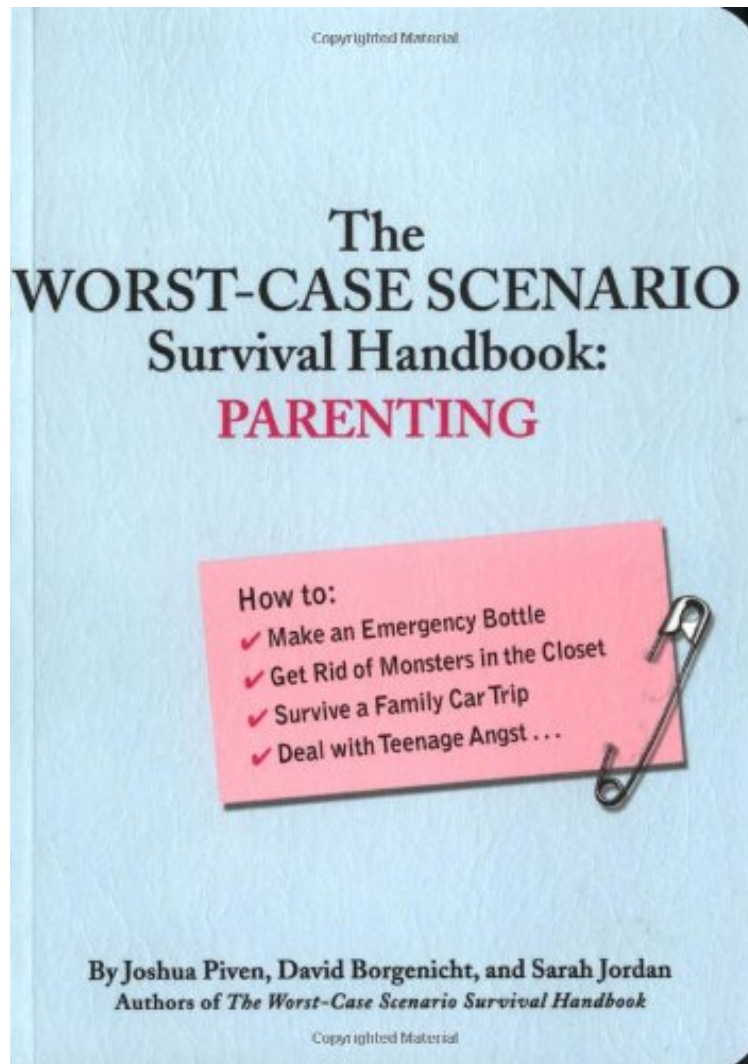

But this "Worst-Case" book will make you giggle and be thankful that you don't have it THAT bad. Yet. On a side note, the section about how to re-capitate a doll really works! I've fixed three action figures using the doll re-heading technique.
